Dear Friends,

What a year. Who could have imagined that a global pandemic would bring the world to a stop, then turn it upside down and inside out? And yet, thanks to your support, our work for the animals never missed a beat.

We continued to take in the most vulnerable and at-risk homeless animals in both Mexico and California's Central Valley. Over the course of the year, we provided over 750 animals with life-saving medical care and rehabilitation before placing them in loving homes.

Our international rescue efforts actually increased in frequency and number as we responded to an enormous influx of homeless animals at our south-of-the-border shelters as a result of economic hardships on families caused by the virus. At the same time, north-of-the-border demand for adoptable animals was unprecedented and our adoption rates skyrocketed.

It is both heartbreaking and heartwarming that the misfortune of some people and the generosity of others allowed us to save more lives than ever.

Alongside our efforts to save each and every life possible, this year we also continued to address the core issues that cause animal homelessness and neglect. Our free and low-cost veterinary and spay/neuter clinics continued at full capacity and served over 8,000 animals last year.

None of this would have been possible without your unwavering support.

Looking ahead, as much as we'd like to think otherwise, we now know that ongoing economic impacts from the pandemic will continue to affect the health and safety of animals in the communities we serve for some time to come. The already overwhelming need for our low-cost and free veterinary services will increase as families' financial situations become even more dire. We are preparing to do all we can to continue to take in and care for an increasing number of homeless animals in need. We ask that you stand beside us as we brace for the year to come.

Thank you for believing in our work. Together, we will continue to provide compassion and care for the animals at a time it is needed most.

OUR PROGRAMS

THE TRIAD OF COMPASSION:

SPAY AND NEUTER, ACCESS TO CARE, RESCUE

ADDRESSING THE ROOT CAUSES OF ANIMAL HOMELESSNESS AND NEGLECT, WHILE ALSO
RESCUING AND REHABILITATING AS MANY ANIMALS AS POSSIBLE.



SPAY AND NEUTER

Providing readily available access to free and low-cost spay and neuter has been a core program for over two decades. Spay/neuter is one of the primary ways to prevent animal homelessness, by decreasing the overall number of unwanted animals in the community. We provide free and low-cost spay/neuter to over 5,000 animals living in poverty each year, both in Mexico and the U.S.

We have a stationary clinic in Mexico that operates five days a week, as well as a monthly sterilization clinic in California.



RESCUE

Each year we rescue vulnerable homeless animals living in poverty on both sides of the border, providing extensive medical and emotional care to rehabilitate each one. Last year we were able to provide direct rescue and rehoming to over 750 animals in need.

We have two shelters in Puerto Peñasco, Mexico and one in Santa Rosa, CA.



ACCESS TO CARE

Access to free and low-cost veterinary care is a critical component in ending the cycle of animal abandonment and suffering. By enabling low-income community members to provide appropriate veterinary care, we keep animals healthy and in the homes with the families who love them. This care prevents animals from being surrendered to shelters or abandoned. We provide access to care to over 3,000 animals each year.

We have community veterinary clinics in underserved communities in California and also provide free care through our stationary clinic in Puerto Peñasco, Mexico.

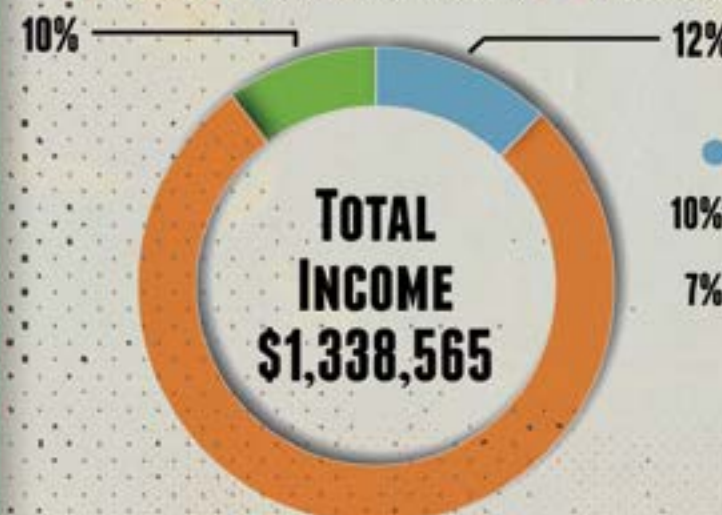

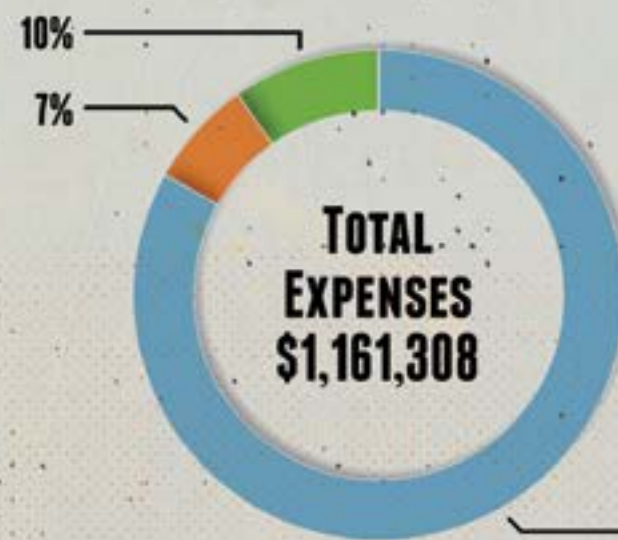
