Dear Friends,

This past year has been a tough one, and that's been especially true for the low-income areas we work in on both sides of the border. The far-reaching impacts of COVID have disproportionately impacted these communities, and the animals in them.



In Mexico, our shelters took in more animals than any previous year due to a sharp increase in animal abandonment and owner surrenders, a result of the severe local economic downturn caused by the pandemic. Meanwhile, we performed a record number of spay/neuter surgeries in the area to stem the tide of growing animal homelessness. Additionally, we expanded our free veterinary and support services to help keep animals in the homes with the folks who love them, but who otherwise could not afford to keep them.

North of the border, our shelter partners in the impoverished areas of the Central Valley of California relied on us more than ever for help with a growing number of medical cases in need of advanced care and veterinary attention. And, the demand for low-cost and free veterinary care and spay/neuter in the low-income communities we serve has never been greater.

Thankfully, because of the steadfast support of caring individuals like you, as the need has grown, so, too, has our ability to respond. Overall, we were able to help nearly 20% more animals than the previous year, expanding our services as much as possible, and taking in more homeless animals than ever before.

Thank you for standing behind us during these tough times. Your generosity and compassion have enabled us to make a bigger impact than ever, when it was truly needed the most.

We may not know what the future holds, but together we will do all we can to be there for the animals, no matter what.

ACCESS TO CARE... NO MATTER WHAT!

The pandemic threw a lot of curveballs our way in terms of safely continuing our access to care programs on both sides of the border. That said, we met the challenge and figured out ways to not only continue our programs, but to actually expand services.

With carefully thought out procedures in place to ensure the health of our staff and clients, we were able to provide free and low-cost services to more animals than in any other year in Mexico.

In the U.S, our work to ensure access to free and low-cost care to underserved populations continued with modified COVID protocols, enabling the animals in those communities to stay healthy and in the homes with the families who love them.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

LIFESAVING PARTNERSHIP TO HELP THE CATS OF MEXICO

We have been primarily saving dogs from Mexico for the past 20 years, with a handful of cats whenever possible. This past year, however, we started a new cat rescue program with HALO, a partner shelter in Phoenix.

Cats and kittens are transferred to HALO every two weeks, after undergoing medical care and a voluntary quarantine with our staff in Mexico. HALO then adopts out the cats through their various adoption centers north of the border. This lifesaving partnership has already saved the lives of several hundreds of cats.



LAND PURCHASE IN MEXICO SETS THE STAGE FOR DREAM FACILITY

We have two shelters and one free clinic in Mexico, all of which are operated out of rented properties. This past year, thanks to the generosity of an incredible donor, we were able to purchase a piece of land that will enable us to build a dream facility with both a clinic and a shelter all in one.

This facility will not only enable us to save more lives, it will improve our ability to provide high level care, and will serve as a training center for veterinarians and other animal welfare professionals throughout Mexico and beyond.

SAFETY NET FOR THE ANIMALS OF THE CENTRAL VALLEY OF CALIFORNIA

While the pandemic initially decreased the number of animals in the under-resourced shelters we help in the Central Valley, that impact was temporary. Over the past year, they have relied on us more than ever to take in their medical cases.

These shelters do not have the resources or veterinary staffing to provide care to animals with significant medical needs, so our partnership provides a critically important safety net to these overcrowded facilities' most vulnerable animals.

RADICAL COMPASSION



MR. BEAN

Mr. Bean arrived at our free clinic in Mexico after being hit by a car. He was unable to walk due to a spinal injury affecting his back legs. Mr. Bean was stabilized, given supportive medical care, and incredibly, after a few weeks, he began to gain strength and walk.

Fast forward a few months and Mr. Bean regained nearly full function of his rear legs, running, romping, and playing like a regular dog. This resilient boy went on to absolutely thrive both physically and emotionally before being adopted out into a loving home.

PANCHO

Darling Pancho was found blind on the streets of Mexico, with a long standing eye condition that he was most likely born with. Pancho underwent care and surgery to remove the painful eyes, and recovered without skipping a beat. He is, without a doubt, one of the most happy, carefree, enthusiastic dogs we rescued all year - an absolute joy to behold.



PACO

Sweet Paco was found in dire conditions in Mexico, living on the end of a chain and so severely matted he was unable to see or even walk normally. Paco was rescued and given extensive medical care, including surgery to remove a severely injured leg, and ongoing treatment for a systemic fungal disease.

Paco spent several months in foster, where he healed with loads of care, medical attention, and love. With time, he transformed into a goofy, healthy, sweet soul without a care in the world. Paco was adopted out into a wonderful home in northern California where he is absolutely adored.



RIO

Rio was found living at a truck stop south of the border. He was very thin, missing a foot and heavily scarred, bearing the physical imprints of great struggle and strife. Yet, despite all he had endured, Rio was incredibly sweet and loving from day 1 of his rescue. This deeply soulful dog melted the heart of everyone who met him.

Rio now lives with a loving family north of the border, and even had a prosthetic boot made for his rear leg that he uses to run and go for long walks.

STEVE, MICHELLE, MISSY AND FREDDY

Missy and Freddy belong to two incredible clients of ours, Steve and Michelle. We first met Steve and Michelle when they were hit with hard times and experiencing homelessness. Despite all the hardship, they were committed to taking excellent care of their dogs and got them fully vaccinated and spayed and neutered through our community clinics.

Thankfully, Steve and Michelle have been able to turn things around. They are both working and are no longer homeless. We are grateful to have been able to be there for them when they needed a bit of support to take care of their loved ones.



BRUCE

Bruce came to us as a medical transfer from a partner shelter in the Central Valley of California. He had been abandoned in a backyard and brought in by a neighbor who had been feeding him, after they found him severely injured all along the back side of his neck and ears.

The injuries, most likely from trying to dig out under a fence, required several reconstructive surgeries and months of care. Bruce, who also bore the emotional scars of his difficult past, spent months recovering in foster before blossoming completely and finding the perfect home.

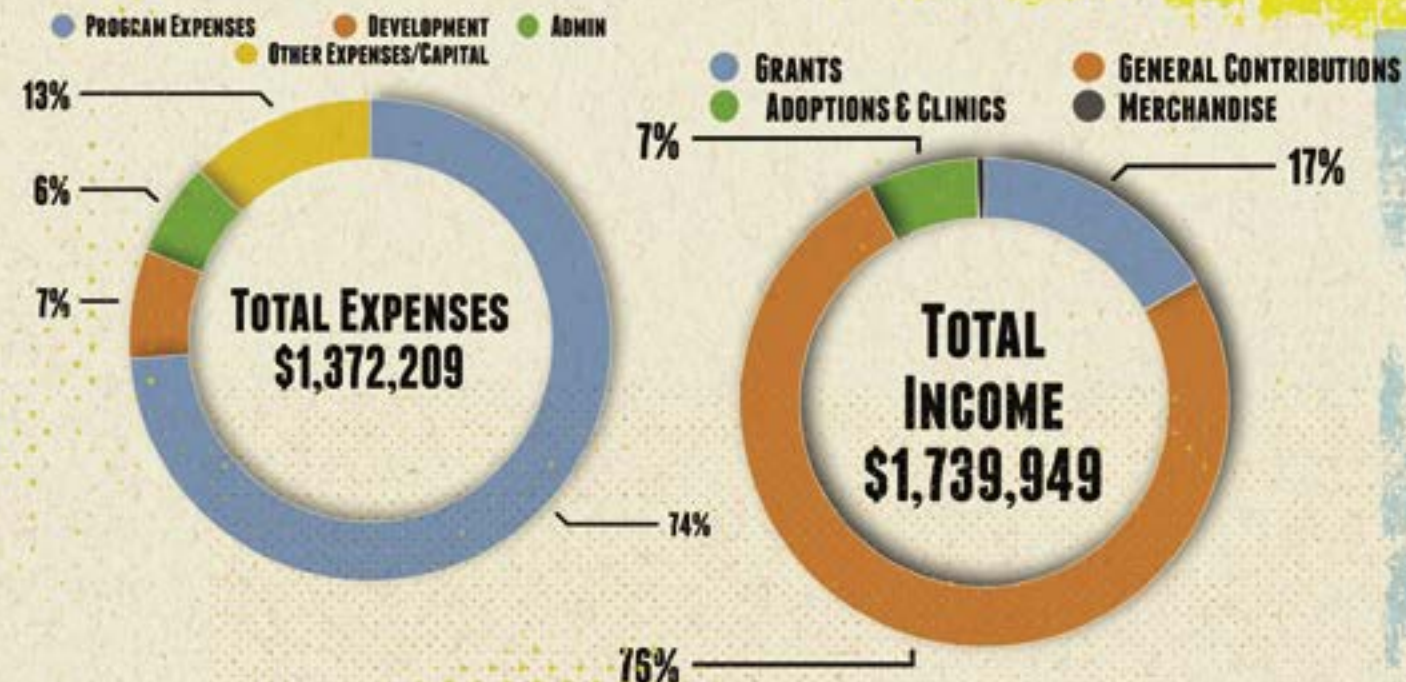


942 ANIMALS RESCUED, REHABILITATED, AND ADOPTED INTO LOVING HOMES
